During holidays, they call for a forum for guidance and counselling. They guide even our parents on how to keep poultry farming. They also give the feeds and guide them on how to manage nursery bed.

After I finished my eight years in primary level the project supported me to join secondary school that is a boarding school. They paid my school fees every term. This helped me not

drop out of school while my colleagues are at school learning.

During holidays the managers of this project employ a teacher who teach us computer studies at OBBITU CHILDREN HOME, and I really benefited and appreciate the effort of this project.

I finished my four years of secondary level in the year March 2021 but I was suppose to finish in the year November 2020, because of outbreak of COVID 19.

I got an average grade which is a c-plain which can make me to qualify for a diploma course. I wanted to apply for Nursing and other related diploma courses.
