2022/01—01: INTRODUCTION:

The meeting began exactly at 10.25 am on Tuesday with a word of prayer from Shekh Kulo.then Mr.Gufu Guyo take over to welcome all committee members to the meeting which was routine and it’s a normal meetings done after every quarter although we were late a bit. he wish everybody a happy new year 2022 and thank God this far we reach as committee and

as project sololo. Mr.Gufu went ahead to inform members that even our supporters are doing well and they have reached this year 2022.

The chairman introduced a new member who is the chief of Anona to also represent his community because its one of our project areas, chiefs represent community and also government at the same time.

Since the secretary to the meeting Mr.Abdub was not present Mr.Abdi Okotu took over to take munit of the meeting and he was invite to read the previous meeting minute.

2022/01/02 READING OF PREVIOUS MINUTE AND MATTERS ARISING

1. Lokho abkula : she send admission of Mio girls but reported to another school called Matere girls; on this issue Mr.Roba Habada asked whether she still attend to school,, if yes ,she should be followed up by area chief Waye who is also in attendance before dropping her from the program. Mr.Gufu,Mr Dako and Abdi all provided on how we followed her up on her case was made severally but finally Chief waye took responsibility to follow up on her case and report back to management.
2. Issue on NHIF services provided by CIPAD. Chief Hussein Kitata Asked if Fatuma Salad family 080 are still benefiting even after exit because there is a child called Abdub salad who held up in the Hospital, management in consultation with Mr.Abdi confirm that the family are still benefiting from NHIF services and thus both inpatient and outpatient are free for all out beneficiaries if other factors like birth certificates remain constant.
3. Mr. Paul elaborated on nutrition assessment and action to be taken to control malnutrition. e.g providing nutritional supplements such as unimix, extra food, and referral to health facilities for supplementary feeding.

2022/01-03 .PARTNERSHIP WITH THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Mr. Gufu narrated on the previous attempt to meet county governor but the plan failed due to lack of appointment with the governor, he went ahead to explain to the members that, we have been emphasizing of donor fatigue and resources to run this center is not available, this was the reason we contacted county government to take ownership of this facilities, deploy staffs and run as a children home and a rescue center.

Going forward the chairman inform members that last time he visited county secretary for the same purpose he was informed that the county government lack child protection policy to manage children's home but now the policy has been formulated and adopted by county assembly therefore it's the high time we meet county governor for directives

On the same note as a way forward the members agreed to form a four member committee to address this issue to the county governor.

The team will immediately take up the issue as a matter of urgency and look for appointment. it was agreed unanimously

2022/01/---04/ PROJECT STATUS REPORT 2021

Mr.GUFU cipad provided to the members the project report for the year ended 2021 He informed them that due to the covid-19 pandemic, the project funding was not as before, people's gathering was ban, the economy went down as some donors lack fund therefore the fundraising for the project sololo was very difficult despite of hardship we managed to do the following in serving our beneficiaries.

As a project our focus was the child to become responsible citizen and realized the future goal and eventually look after their family.

Here are the report provided by chairman to the members:

- Household supported by sololo project-----100
- Children in secondary school----- 54
- Children in primary school-----205
- Children under school going age and preprimary---101
- Children in technical school-----2
- Children in other collages-----2.
- Total number of children supported by sololo project---364
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Services provided during the year 2021 included the following

1. Health care - NHIF enrollment – 109 families total beneficiaries – 415 (adult and children)
2. Food distribution – 100 families – maize and beans distributed according to family size
3. Shelter construction with pit latrines – 6
4. Kit casa provided 21 families
5. Home clothes for children – 156
6. 100 litre container – 21
7. Mattresses medium size 3X6 ft – 26
8. Beds 3X6 – 10
9. Blankets – large size 4X6 – 158

2022/01—05/ OVC FAMILIES TO BE EXITED AND POSSIBLE REPLACEMENT

The chairman remanded the members that sololo project has assisted many people in various part around Sololo, uran and obbu ward. the selection and exit is done in consultation with this management committee.

He went ahead and explained to the members that the number of beneficiaries depends on the donor funding which of late has gone down due to covid-19 pandemic.

This days the admission to the project will depend on the number of household exited by this committee this means we cannot go beyond the capacity of the project hence disadvantaging the service to other beneficiaries.

The chairman tabled before the committee 3 beneficiaries who if they agreed will be exited with the reasons for exit.

This includes.

1. Ilad denge –Fam-090 reason for exit is Child moved to Nairobi therefore no children to serve from the household.

2.Kule Nyuke – fam-002 reason for exit is child graduate to secondary and to move to student database therefore no child to serve from the household.

3.Sake Godana -022.reason for exit –mother is drunkard every time, neglecting the children, selling food provided by the program to buy alcohol, Mr.Gufu said cipad will take care of the education of the children, one child already admitted to Obbitu children, one to be admitted in Hawecha primary boarding, onne is form 2 to request for transfer to Dr. Guracha memorial girls school from Sololo Mix day secondary school. Members said they have no objection as everybody knows the behavior of Sake Godana but they ask on what will happen to this children during school holidays a question the chairman said we shall answer that question when we reach that time of holiday because the mother might reform and take responsibility of her child or else we shall see what will happen when we reach that day.

On issue of exiting these families, all members agreed, the reason was satisfactory the caregivers to be given one month and suggestion were made on how to replace them.

One genuine case reported unanimously was the case which recently happened at Badan rero where one person from sololo was killed in the battle field because of Borana and the children left orphan. the members agreed to add this family to the project .

That is TUME OKOTU has one child from sololo town.
