a) VARIATION OF FEES

You will not be registered as a student before payment of the required fees.

2. OTHER CONDITIONS FOR REGISTRATION

- i. Your studies will be governed by the common regulations for undergraduate students and the regulations of your respective schools in accordance with the joining instructions contained in the forms **KU/1, KU/2, KU3A/KU3B, KU/6, KU/7 and KU/8**. All these documents are accessed through KU website (<http://www.ku.ac.ke/admission/joining-instructions>). Download and fill the forms accordingly and return to the University on the registration day.
- ii. The University reserves the right of admission. Any offer of admission is made without prejudice to right of the University to vary or withdraw it if information comes to the notice of the University (whether relating to events occurring before or after the date of the offer) which could reasonably have influenced the University's decision if known at the time the offer was made.
- iii. **The University shall conduct verification of your academic documents in consultation with Kenya National Examination Council (KNEC) within the first month of your admission. You will therefore be required to submit two (2) scanned (coloured) copies of your certificates/ result-slips on the date of registration.**
- iv. The University reserves the right to withdraw an offer of a place, or terminate a student's enrolment if it discovers subsequently that a candidate has given false (or only provided partial) information in their application or has provided false or fraudulent documentation in support of their application(s).
- v. Holders of Diploma Certificates who wish to be considered for credit waivers are advised to bring certified copies of their Diploma certificate, transcripts and course content since they will fill the credit waiver application form during the registration process in the University.

NB:

- 1. You are advised to bring your own laptop to enable you access the necessary e-learning resources and actively participate in some of the courses offered online. Such laptops will need to be registered with the University library for ease of tracking and use.**
- 2. Some Compulsory University Academic Programmes and activities may take place on Saturdays and Sundays, including administration of examinations. All students are expected to adhere to the University schedule.**
- 3. Please note that due to limited accommodation spaces, admission does not guarantee you accommodation in University hostels.
